## CIRCULAR

DAT – Revised procedure for release of funds under CSS and monitoring Sub: utilisation of funds released - Reg.

1. O.M.No.F.No.1(13)PFMS/FCD/2020, dated 23.03.2021 of the Ministry of Ref: Finance, Department of Expenditure(PFMS Division), New Delhi.

2. Letter No.F.No.1(13)/PFMS/FCD/2021, dated 30.06.2021 of the Director, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, New Delhi.

3. Letter No.F.No.1(13)/PFMS/FCD/2020, dated 02.07.2021 of the Director, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, New Delhi.

Copy of the letter cited under reference 2, issued by the Director, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure (PFMS Division), New Delhi, is enclosed herewith for perusal. It is stated therein that the Single Nodal Agency (SNA) of each CSS in the State shall compute the total interest earned out of the funds received in its account (both from the Central Govt. and the State Govt.) in the preceding financial year in the 1st week of April. The interest earned should be apportioned by the SNA between the Central and the State Govt. as per the approved funding pattern of the CSS and shall be deposited in the Consolidated Funds viz., '0049 - 02 - 800' & '0049 - 04 - 800' respectively.

In the current financial year 2021-22, such calculation may be done as on 15.10.2021. An undertaking shall be furnished to the Ministry concerned of the Central Govt. by the Secretary of the State Govt. in the enclosed format every year alongwith the proposal for release of the 1st instalment of funds under the CSS. For the current financial year 2021-22, the undertaking shall be furnished by 31st October, 2021.

Copy of the letter cited under reference 3 is also enclosed herewith for perusal, wherein it is informed that relaxation of 3 months time has been granted for the implementation of Point No.11 and 13. The said Point Nos.11 & 13 are given below:

Point No.11: Relaxation of 3 months i.e., upto September, 2021 in opening of separate heads for Central and the State Share for each CSS in the Detailed Demand for Grants (DDG) of States;

**Point No.13**: Relaxation of 3 months i.e., upto September, 2021 in the provision regarding refund of unspent funds currently available in the bank account of Implementing Agencies (IAs) into the Single Nodal Account of the Single Nodal Agency concerned.

All other remaining provisions contained in the OM dated 23.03.2021, shall be implemented strictly w.e.f.  $1^{\rm st}$  July, 2021.

2. All Head of Departments dealing with CSS are therefore requested to bestow their personal attention in this matter for strict compliance. A compliance report in this regard should be sent to this Directorate on or before 30.09.2021.

Please refer to para 10 of this Department's letter of even number dated 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 2021 wherein it is stated that:

"The SNAs shall ensure that the interest earned from the funds released should be mandatorily remitted to the respective Consolidated Funds on pro-rata basis in terms of Rule 230(8) of GFR, 2017. Interest earned should be clearly and separately depicted in PFMS, scheme-specific portals integrated with PFMS and in MIS provided by banks."

2. In this regard, it is clarified that the Single Nodal Agency (SNA) of each CSS in the State shall compute the total interest earned out of the funds received in its account (both from the Central Government and the State Government) in the preceding financial year in the 1<sup>st</sup> week of April. The interest earned will be apportioned by the SNA between the Central and the State Government as per the approved funding pattern of the CSS and shall be deposited in the respective Consolidated Funds. In the current financial year (2021-22) such calculation may be done as on 15<sup>th</sup> October, 2021.

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- 3. For Central Government, the amount shall be deposited in the Major Head 0049, Submajor Head 01, Minor Head (i.e.0049-01-800) by the States and in the Major Head 0049, Sub-major Head-02, Minor Head 800 (i.e. 0049-02-800) by the UTs with Legislature.
- 4. An undertaking shall be furnished to this effect to the Ministry concerned of the Central Government by the Secretary of the State Government in the enclosed format every year along with the proposal for release of the 1<sup>st</sup> instalment of funds under the CSS. For the current financial year (2021-22) such undertaking shall be furnished by 31<sup>st</sup> October, 2021.
