NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India read with the Notification No. F.5/4/65-GP, dated 11th January, 1965 of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, and in supersession of the Notification issued by G. O. Rt. No. 190/71/P1, dated 6th August 1971 and G. O. Ms. No. 227/77/P1 A, dated December 1977 published in supplement to the Gazette, No. 36 of the 7th September 1971 and supplement to the Gazette No. 50 of the 13th December 1977 respectively, save as respects the work done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Lieutenant-Governor, Pondicherry, hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Group 'C' posts of Stock Verifier/Store-keeper Grade-I, Store-keeper Grade-II and Store-keeper Grade-III in various departments of the Government of Pondicherry, namely:—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry, (Stock Verifier/Store-keeper Grade-I, Store-keeper Grade-II and Store-keeper Grade-III) Recruitment Rules, 1991.

(2) They shall come into force on and from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. *Application.*— These rules shall apply for recruitment to the posts specified in columns 1 to 4 of the Schedules annexed hereto.

3. *Number of posts, their classifications and scales of pay.*— The number of the said posts, their classifications and scales of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedules.

4. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.*— The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns 5 to 15 of the said Schedules.

5. *Disqualifications.*— No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living;

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person;

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Lieutenant-Governor, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and there are no grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. *Power to relax.*— Where the Lieutenant-Governor is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any or all the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxation in upper age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special category of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

6. Whether benefit of added years of service admissible under rule 30 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972.	No
