

RECRUITMENT RULES

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GOVERNMENT OF PONDICHERRY
FINANCE DEPARTMENT

(G. O. Ms. No. 20/94/F5, dated 9th March 1994)

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the Notification No. F.5/4/65-GP, dated 11th January, 1965 of the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi and in supersession of the Notification No. 27792/Dev./E1/63, dated 31st January 1969 of the Department of Public Works, Pondicherry published in Supplement to the Gazette No. 14 of the 8th April 1969, read with G. O. Rt. No. 173/72/F1, dated 30th May 1972 of the Finance Department, Pondicherry and published in supplement to the Gazette No. 25, dated 20th June, 1972 and G. O. Ms. No. 57/92/F5, dated 3rd November 1992 save as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Administrator, Pondicherry, hereby makes following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'B' post of Store Superintendent in various Departments, Government of Pondicherry, namely :—

1. *Short title and commencement.*— (1) These rules may be called the Government of Pondicherry (Store Superintendent) Recruitment Rules, 1994.

(2) They shall come into force on and from the date of their publication in the official gazette.

2. *Number of posts, its classification and scale of pay.*— The number of the said posts, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. *Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications.*— The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto, shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. *Disqualifications.*— No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts :

Provided that the Administrator, may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. *Power to relax.*— Where the Administrator is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. *Saving.*— Nothing in these rules shall affect the reservations, relaxation in upper age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the scheduled castes, the scheduled tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Government from time to time in this regard.

RECRUITMENT RULES FOR THE POST OF STORE SUPERINTENDENT

| 3. Classification | General Central Services Group 'B' (Gazetted—Non-Ministerial). |
| 4. Scale of pay | Rs. 2,000-60-2,300-EB-75-3,200. |
| 5. Whether selection or non-selection post | Selection. |
| 6. Age limit for direct recruits | Not applicable. |
| 7. Whether benefit of added years of service admissible under rule 30 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972. | No |
| 8. Educational and other qualifications required for direct recruits. | Not applicable. |
| 9. Whether age and educational qualifications prescribed for direct recruits will apply in the case of promotees. | Not applicable. |

Note: For being considered for promotion, a pass in Accounts Test for Subordinate Officers is essential.

Transfer on deputation:

Officers of the Central/State Governments/Union Territories—

- (a) (i) holding analogous posts on a regular basis; or
- (ii) with 3 years' regular service in posts in the scale of pay of Rs. 1,640-2,900 or equivalent; or

- (iii) with 5 years' regular service in posts in the scale of pay of Rs. 1,600-2,660 or equivalent; or
- (iv) with 7 years' regular service in posts in the pay scale of Rs. 1,400-2,300/2,600 or equivalent; and
- (b) possessing a University Degree or equivalent with at least 3 years' experience in handling Stores and Accounts of Store in a Supervisory capacity.

The departmental officers in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation.

Similarly, deputationist shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

[Period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding to this appointment in the same or some other organisation/department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not to exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by transfer on deputation (including short-term contract) shall be, not exceeding 56 years, as on the closing date of receipt of application].
